Household Hazardous Waste and Scrap Tire Collection Events Cancellations

Grand Traverse County, MI (May 11, 2020) – Due to the extension on the “Stay Home Stay Safe” Executive Order, the Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) and the Scrap Tire collection events that were scheduled for May 14th have been canceled. If you had an appointment to these events, you have already received an email with instructions on how to sign up for the June 18th events.

HHW drop-off events are by appointment only. Appointments can be made using the online scheduling system at <http://www.recyclesmart.info/1162>. If you do not have internet access, you can call the RecycleSmart Hotline at 231-941-5555.

Subsequent events will be held on August 6th and Saturday September 26th.

Items accepted at the HHW collection events include: oil-based paint, solvents, automotive fluids, household cleaners, lawn and garden chemicals, batteries, fluorescent light bulbs and more. Find a complete list of acceptable material at <http://recyclesmart.info/1213>.
