
MCR.110(F)(1) provides for an administrative order to establish the hours of the court.

The hours of the court for Grand Traverse County shall be 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. Monday through Friday.

The hours of the court for Leelanau and Antrim Counties shall be from 9:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. on those days in which a Circuit Judge is scheduled to preside over a motion day, generally the second and third Monday of each month, respectively. If a holiday falls on a regularly scheduled Monday motion day, court shall be held on the next day.

Jury trials in the Circuit shall begin at 8:30 A.M.
