Grand Traverse County COVID-19 Case Investigation Breakdown Aug. 31 - Sept. 1

For Wednesday, September 2, 2020, the Grand Traverse County Health Department is reporting six new cases of COVID-19. Wednesday's additions bring the total case count to 324, with 181 recovered and seven deaths, leaving 136 active cases.

While conducting case investigations, the health department determined that a confirmed COVID-19 case was present at the location listed below during the specified dates and times.

TC Eagles 383/Fraterna

Monday, August 24: 3:45 - 9 p.m.
Wednesday, August 26: 11 a.m. - 4 p.m.
Thursday, August 27: 11 a.m. - 4 p.m.

If you were present at this location during the listed time periods, you should self-monitor for COVID-19 symptoms for 14 days since the possible exposure, **particularly if you were not wearing a mask or maintaining 6 foot distance from others**. Symptoms include: fever, cough, shortness of breath, vomiting, diarrhea, muscle aches, repeated shaking with chills, headache, sore throat and new loss of taste or smell. **Anyone that is self-monitoring as a result should keep away from the public, family, close contacts and roommates as much as possible.**

From August 31 through September 1 Grand Traverse County Health Department completed 10 case investigations for confirmed COVID-19 cases. The following is information known at this time:

- All 10 cases are primary residents.
- Ages:
0-19 3
20-29 2
50-59 1
60-69 1
70-79 3
- Symptomatic: 8 Asymptomatic: 2
- 4 are linked to travel either into or out of the area as reported during the case investigation
- 2 are linked to large group gatherings or social events
- 4 cases were known close contacts to other positive cases
- Approximately 35 close contacts were identified, notified, and instructed to quarantine.

Case Investigations were also completed on **4** probable cases (individuals who were close contacts of a positive COVID case who became symptomatic during their quarantine).
