Grand Traverse County Case Investigation Breakdown - November 2, 2020

For November 2, 2020, Grand Traverse County Health Department is reporting 13 new cases and a total of 43 cases from Saturday, Sunday, and Monday combined. The total case count is now 821, with 475 recovered, 13 deaths, leaving 333 active cases.

There are no visitor cases to report and one place of possible community exposure identified:

Rove Estate Vineyard & Winery on Saturday, October 31 4:30 - 6:30 pm

If you are a newly diagnosed/COVID 19+ tested case, please self-isolate. Due to the continued large volume of cases and case investigations needing to be completed, The Grand Traverse County Health Department is asking for your patience and cooperation until we can reach you directly. Additionally, notify any of your close contacts that they will need to quarantine until contact tracing can be completed for 14 days from their last contact with you and monitor for symptoms. If symptoms arise, get tested.

From October 30th through November 1st, the Grand Traverse County Health Department completed 34 case investigations for confirmed COVID-19 cases. The following is information known at this time:

- All 34 cases are primary residents
- Ages:

0-19	5
20-29	8
30-39	6
40-49	2
50-59	4
60-69	5
70-79	2
80-89	1
90-99	1

- Symptomatic: 31 Asymptomatic: 3
- 7 are linked to travel either into or out of the area as reported during the case investigation
- 8 are linked to large group gatherings or social events
- 21 cases were known close contacts to other positive cases

- Approximately 97 close contacts were identified, notified, and instructed to quarantine.

Case Investigations were also completed on 7 probable case (individuals who were close contacts of a positive COVID case who became symptomatic during their quarantine)
