The Grand Traverse County Health Department (GTCHD) is hosting a few adult COVID-19 and flu vaccination walk-in clinics in February for the community.

“It’s not too late to get your flu or COVID-19 vaccine,” said GTCHD Communicable Disease and Immunization Supervisor Jacalyn Money-Bruno, MPH, BSN, RN, CIC. “These viruses are circulating in our community and the vaccines can prevent illness or decrease the severity of illness.”
