FREE TAX HELP FOR SENIORS: STRESS-FREE FILING WITH NMCAA

The Northwest Michigan Community Action Agency (NMCAA) provides free tax preparation services designed to support seniors with low-to-moderate incomes. Certified volunteers ensure accurate filing of federal and state returns while helping maximize refunds and credits. This secure, IRS-approved program offers seniors a stress-free way to meet tax obligations and save money. EXCITING UPDATE: MORE TRANSPORTATION VOUCHERS AVAILABLE IN 2025!

Starting in January, we're offering more transportation vouchers than ever to help meet your needs.

What's New?

- Monthly Limit: Up to \$120 worth of vouchers (24 vouchers).
- Quarterly Limit: Up to \$360 worth of vouchers (72 vouchers).

How to Request Vouchers

You can choose:

1. Monthly Requests: Get vouchers for one month at a time.
2. Quarterly Requests: Get vouchers for three months at once.

Quarter Schedules

Vouchers are only available for the current month or the current quarter (not past periods). Each quarter is as follows:

- Quarter 1: January–March
- Quarter 2: April–June
- Quarter 3: July–September
- Quarter 4: October–December

Payment Information

- Payment is due at the time of request unless you qualify as a non-paying tier.
