- Well/Septic Permit and Evaluation refund requests will be refunded as follows:
 - Requested prior to any fieldwork: 100% less \$35 processing fee
 - Fieldwork complete, but no report: 50% less \$35 processing fee
 - Final report or permit has been processed and issued: No Refund
